DEPOSITS

Electric

- Residential: Two-twelfths of estimated annual billings with a minimum deposit of \$100 and a maximum deposit of \$300.
- Non-Residential: Two-twelfths of estimated annual billings or as determined by the District.

Water

- Residential: None if with an electric account.
Two-twelfths of estimated annual billing if water only.
- Non-Residential: None if with an electric account.
Two-twelfths of estimated annual billing if water only.

Satisfactory credit record with the District or credit reference may allow the District to waive the deposit requirement.
