### **PUD Board of Commissioners Appoint David Anderson to Fill Commissioner Vacancy**

Carlsborg, WA – September 18, 2018 – At a special public meeting on September 17, Clallam County PUD Commissioners appointed David L. Anderson to fill the vacant Commissioner District 2 position that arose as a consequence of the resignation of Commissioner Hugh Haffner. Mr. Anderson will serve the remaining term through the certification of the general election on November 24, 2020.

Mr. Anderson is a 15-year Clallam PUD customer. He spent thirteen years with Seattle City Light as a Project Manager on the design and construction of utility projects, as well as fifteen years prior in construction and project management roles. With a Masters degree in Construction Management, his experience will be invaluable to understanding the District's infrastructure and future planning as the PUD grows. His application reflected his interest in serving the community noting that his interest in the position is "to assure that management of the PUD continues to provide reliable and affordable power, water and wastewater..." adding that the opportunity would allow him to expand his engagement in community service. General Manager Doug Nass commented "We look forward to Mr. Anderson's contribution to the Commission from his many years of utility experience and teaching at the college level."

The position of PUD Commissioner pays a salary of \$2,567 per month, plus a per diem of \$128 per day for meetings attended on behalf of the District to a maximum annual compensation of \$48,724, pursuant to RCW 54.12.080. Commissioners are also eligible for group insurance for themselves, their immediate family, and dependents.

Clallam PUD has 145 employees, and serves over 31,000 accounts in Clallam County with energy from 98% clean, renewable, affordable and carbon-free sources.
